



2002 W.M.C. Championship Performance Autocross Series event # 4

Sunday, September 15, 2002
@ Les Schwab parking lot

This is the fourth event in a new autocross series put on by Willamette Auto Club. Points will be awarded based on your class finish in each event to determine the overall class champion at the end of the year! Please arrive early enough so you have time to register, get teched, and walk the course **before** the start of your run group!

WHERE: **Les Schwab Tires at 2350 Mission St.** In Salem take the Mission St/Hwy 22 exit from I-5, west past Costco and car dealers on your right, go past 2 stop lights, just past the K-mart on the west side of the K-Mart parking lot.

TIME: Registration and Tech: morning Run Groups open at 7:30 am and CLOSE at 8:45 am. Registration and Tech: afternoon Run Groups open at 11:30am and CLOSE at 12:45pm. Classifications will be per 2002 SCCA Solo II and WMC Series rulebook.

All run group times are tentative. However, plan to be early so you don't miss your run group. If you don't know which group you run in, call INFO below so you'll know when to arrive (am or pm) or come early so we can class your car.

NOVICES: If you've never run an autocross before, a novice class will be running all day long. We will register and tech your car when you arrive during scheduled registration times

SAFETY: You must wear an approved helmet (Snell 90 or better) in order to compete. Loaner helmets are available, but are in short supply. Shoes are also required (no sandals, open toed). Your car **MUST** be equipped with seatbelts and be in good working order (brakes, tires, etc.). No studded or temporary use tires. No loose objects in car. No loose bungee corded batteries--solid mount only.

COST: \$20 per driver. \$15 for WMC members. \$35 total if you join WMC the day of the event

ALSO: Noise restrictions are also in place for this event, set at 92dB @ 50 ft.
