

VOS COMPUTERS 2008 AUTOX SERIES EVENTS #7 & #8 and IROC Presented by Custom Audio, JS Alternator and Starter Supply, and Small World Auto Center

Please read the following information carefully. **NOTE THE LOCATION AND THE REGISTRATION TIMES.**

WHEN: Saturday and Sunday, September 6th and 7th 2008

WHERE: COCA COLA BOTTLING, 2980 Chad Drive, Eugene, OR. From I-5 take Beltline west to the Coburg Rd exit, then one block north on Coburg Rd. to Chad Drive, turn right and go east 'till you see us. This area will be heavily patrolled. *If you are caught racing or making excessive noise off the course you will be asked to leave immediately!*

TIME: Registration and Tech for morning Run Groups opens at 7:30am, **CLOSES** at 8:30am. Registration and Tech for afternoon Run Groups opens at 11:30am, **CLOSES** at 12:30pm. Classifications will be per SCCA Solo, and EESCC Autocross Handbook. **Register at your assigned time only, per the classes below.** You can register and tech for both events at once.

Due to IROC the only NFT runs allowed are those that are your only runs of the day.
IROC runs will be run all day, so contenders should be there all day.

All times **EXCEPT REGISTRATION TIMES** are tentative. If you don't know which group you run, come early so we can class your car, or call INFO below.

NOVICES: If you've never run an Autocross before, a Novice class will be running all day long and we will register and tech your car during either the morning or afternoon registration sessions.

SAFETY: Your car must be equipped with seatbelts and be in good working order (brakes, tires, etc.). No studded or temporary use tires. No loose objects in car. You must wear a helmet (Snell 90 or newer) in order to compete. Loaner helmets will be available if you don't own one. Real shoes are required, no sandals or flip flops. All vehicles must pass a technical safety inspection. No loose or bungee corded batteries, solid mount only.

COST: **PER DAY-** \$25 driver. \$20 for EESCC members. \$35 if you join EESCC the day of the event. Receive a \$1 discount for a canned food donation to Food for Lane County.

NOTE - We need course workers! If you want to take home the trophy you win you must volunteer to work the course during the event. Members, please help as much as possible.

ALSO - Come early for Registration and Tech as they **WILL CLOSE** at **8:30 AM** for the morning session and **12:30 PM** for the afternoon.
