

# EESCC Car Number & Class Letter Requirements

These are the new guidelines. EESCC will **NOT** furnish numbers or letters except to novices. It is your responsibility to have your numbers & letters on your car and legible in order to pass tech and to run.

- Shoe polish is not allowed. No lettering or numbers on car or windows with polish is allowed.
- All numbers and class letters must be in a simple readable font and style. (Arial is a good one) No fancy script fonts will be accepted.
- Numbers must be at least 8" high with a 1.25" stroke
- Letters must be at least 4" high with a .75" stroke
- Must have a good contrast against the car color. Light colored cars use black or other very dark color. Dark colored cars use white, yellow, or other light bright color.
- Car number and class letters must be on both sides of the car.
- May use any material or type of lettering, but **MUST BE THE PROPER HEIGHT AND STROKE ON THE LETTERING AND NUMBERS AND BE OF A PROPER CONTRAST COLOR TO THE CAR COLOR.**
- You may print your numbers from your computer printer but must follow the above rules.

Remember, if you have two drivers in your car, it is easy to use a #1 to add to the beginning of your numbers (or to the end of your numbers) when that second person is driving to identify them (example: #34, #134). **Arrange that number combination with registration.**

If your numbers and letters aren't legible and/or don't follow the above rules, you will not pass tech or be allowed to run.
