

2016 Current Noise Restrictions

There is a **95 db** noise limit at all EESCC autocross events. This may be lower than some other autocross clubs run – it is necessary to keep our sites.

Noise will be monitored consistent with established monitoring practices used by SCCA. If the car is recorded with any 94 – 95 db reading, the driver will be given an informational warning from the Safety Steward or Grid. If the car is recorded with a 96 db or greater reading the driver will be asked to modify the car in some manner to reduce the noise before another run is allowed. If the car records another run at 96db or greater, the car will not be allowed to run again that day and that run will be scored a DNF. No refunds will be given. Please make sure your cars are well under the limit. Thank you very much for complying. Excessive noise does not translate into speed
