

**MEETING NOTES** February 7<sup>TH</sup> 2001

President <u>Cheryl Baugh</u> called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.. Secretary <u>Gail Bauer</u> read the minutes from last January's meeting. A correction was noted: A cotton long sleeved shirt is required <u>only</u> at Hillclimb. A clarification was noted: Of the 8 races this season we will count the best 6 for year-end trophies. A competitor must run at least 6 races (2/3 of the series, rounded up to the nearest whole race) to receive a year end trophy.

Treasurer Jim Mueller gave the treasurer's report.

## **Old Business**

We discussed the fees that were mentioned as due for this coming season.Autocross fees for the trophy series are as follows:Members\$15.00Non members\$20.00IceBreaker fees will be\$5.00 higher, to help pay for special T-shirts.Members\$20.00Non members\$25.00

There are several options for paying. You can pre-pay for the remainder of the season as late as the 4<sup>th</sup> event, however once you pre-pay there are **no** refunds.

This racing season we can look forward to having 4-5 runs per event day, with the exception of IceBreaker where we may have 3 runs due to large attendance. A reminder to dress warmly for Ice Breaker, as it is often *chilly* this time of year.

Tim Steck brought up point calculations, he passed out his proposed new system for trophy point calculation for everyone to review. Tim explained the pros and cons, comparing the prososed and existing systems. Cheryl asked if we could try it out by running both systems in parallel for a while, just to see how this works. After a great deal of discussion, a majority of those present voted to retain the current calculation system.

## **NEW BUSINESS**
