The fastest "door slammer" is the Corvette of Bill Cooper, who did a 108.638 (OSPO). The fastest Street Prepared Car was Bill Cooper (not listed), who had a 111.904 (ASP) in his Z06 Corvette with Tim Steck close behind, who did it in 112.706 (ESP) in his Camaro. The fastest Stock Class car to break the 2 minute barrier was Tim Steck (not listed), who did a 113.933 (AS), in his Pontiac Solstice. The fastest Street Mod car was Robert Steck, who did a 111.283 (SM) in his Subura STI.

There are members who have broken the 2 minute barrier more than once in different classes, with Dave Kipperman doing it in 5 classes (GT3, HCP, OSPO, SPO, SPO, SPU), Brad Moffett doing it in 4 classes (OSPO, SM, SPO, SPU), with Jim and Bonnie Mueller doing it in 3 classess (FA, FC, FL) and Tim and Peggy Steck doing it in three classes (AS/ASL, BS/BSL, ESP/ESPL). There are a total of 79 drivers who are members of the Sub-Two Minute Club.
