Meeting Minutes – Secretary, Peggy Steck read the March 4th, 2026 meeting minutes. They were approved as read.

Treasurers Report – Jim Mueller read the treasurers report and it was approved.

Business

Event 1 & 2 Setup – Bert – Trailers are handled and potties are ordered. Bonnie and Tim will design the course. Setup is at 1pm Friday.

Sponsor update – Mary R – No updates, but not everyone has paid. Mary will remind them.

Ice breaker Recap – Bert – The courses were short, but it worked out fine with 5 runs for all and getting out of VRC at 4:30. A pole got hit at finish, so we will need to make adjustments at finish in the future.

Hill Climbs – Mike G – Nothing new. It's getting close to the drop-dead date for Insurance for the Cope Myers hill climb. Registration will open soon on the NHA website.

Evo School – Paula – It's verified that Saturday is phase 1 and Sunday is the challenge school. There are 12 attendees signed up for phase 1 and 17 attendees for the challenge school. The cap is 24 for phase 1 and 18 for the challenge.

She has the timing equipment from the Boeing club reserved, she will ask one of them to come set it up. Dana and Allen will come and run timing for two days. Other people have also volunteered. She has been trying to get ahold of Mike with questions about the coaching staff. And she has been in touch with Jim Merryman about borrowing their equipment again. He said to just remind him.

Insurance – Bonnie – She went with the same policy as SCCA's. We can now have permitted 15 yr old drivers. They must have a parent or club member ride with them. She couldn't find anything on passengers. The Medford club allows 12 yr old passengers. We allow 14 yr olds and voted to keep that limit. Both parents have to sign a release/waiver.

We have joined together with other clubs to get insurance as a group. The prices this year were high, so we went with SCCA's insurance and then the group countered and was able to get a better price. So next year we will go with the group.

Noise Limit – Bonnie said our sound meter is fine. She was asked if we were going to have sound limits at Glide. "Yes, we are", it's a small community and we need to be polite. So, we need to keep the sound down.

New speakers – Tim – the new wireless speakers have arrived. He is setting them up with external batteries that will last an entire weekend. These batteries are the same as the display batteries, so they will be interchangeable. He will test them out and then take them to Berts to put in the trailer.

Additional Agenda Items:

Bonnie – She asked Tim to change how her registration forms print and he will fix it. He is waiting on her to give him specifics.

They upgraded the springs on their pickup, so they can tow the timing trailer now.

Keith and Paula – They went to a WMC event and met someone who had not heard of our club. They only used MSR and we are not on there. Bonnie answered that we need to figure out how to do some things, nft's, discounts for all season, etc. She will work with Nadine to figure things out as soon as Nadine has time.

Keith then asked about sponsor banners like we found in the trailer when cleaning. John Schmidt made them and he will make one for this year.
