Event 3 & 4 planning – Bert – Jim and Bonnie will pull the timing trailer and Keith will pull the reg trailer with Berts truck. Setup is scheduled for Friday at 1pm. Jim asked to move the food vendor closer to spectators. Bert replied that he thought between his trailer and the reg trailer would be a good spot. Spectator viewing area and parking was discussed.

Course Maps – Tim brought two options, #2 was the most popular. Overlap is a concern with both. Bonnie also brought a couple of options and they also look good.

Hill Climbs – Mike G – Larison planning is underway. He is waiting for insurance renewal notification. The forest service is ok waiting until the last of June on the insurance. Bonnie – She suggested the Banquet theme be the 60th anniversary. We decided the banquet theme without any of the committee members present. 😊
